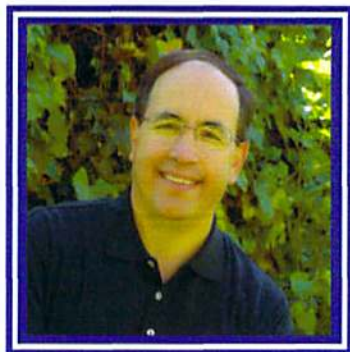


Rev. John M. Palmer Speaker



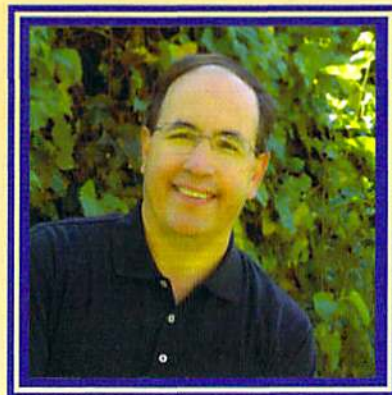
- Married Debbie in 1975

What to bring for lodging at Kamp Kinship:

Sleeping bag, bedding, towel, wash cloth & toiletries

Kamp Kinship, Deadwood, SD Location:

From Rapid City take highway 44 west, at 385 turn right toward Deadwood. Continue 12 miles on 385. Kamp Kinship is located between mile marker 111 and 112. There will be a blue state sign that reads "Kinship Ministries". Turn on Paha Sapa Road — a gravel road to Kamp Kinship is 3-1/2 miles. From Deadwood go south on 385 to Paha Sapa Road.
